Lt Col Romeo and Josephine Bass Ferretti Scholarship Requirements and Application

Description

This scholarship is made possible by a bequest from the estate of Lt Col Romeo and Josephine Bass Ferretti and was established for minor dependents of active duty or retired Air Force, Air Force Reserve or Air National Guard **enlisted airmen**. It is for students pursuing an undergraduate degree in the area of science, technology, engineering or math (STEM). The scholarship will be awarded to a student who has graduated from high school in 2012 and who is entering their first year at an accredited institution of high learning.

Scholarships will be awarded for the 2012-2013 school year in the amount of \$2,500. Recipients will be selected by committee based upon high academic achievement, good character and financial need.

Once the recipients are selected, the Air Force Association will notify them with a letter of congratulations. The recipients' college or university will receive the check, which can be used for any education related expense.

Time Frames

Applications will be accepted by the Air Force Association beginning in January, 2012.

The deadline to submit completed applications is June 30, 2012. (The application package must be complete and received no later than June 30, 2012. No exceptions to the deadline.)

Checks will be issued to the recipients' college/university in September, 2012.

Application Requirements

1. A completed application form (which is located below this description of requirements).
2. A two page (typed and double spaced) essay describing your academic achievements and goals. Also describe how this scholarship will help you achieve those goals.
3. One letter of recommendation. This letter may be written by a teacher, a supervisor or the director of an organization in which you participate.
4. An official, original transcript of your high school grades.
5. Proof of acceptance into an accredited college/university indicating your intended major which must be in one of the STEM fields of study (science, technology, engineering or math). The letter must be on college/university stationery from the admissions office, registrar or financial aid office. The letter must include a statement of the cost of tuition and fees for the first term of attendance.
6. A photo of the applicant (preferably a head shot) which we may use in our publications.
