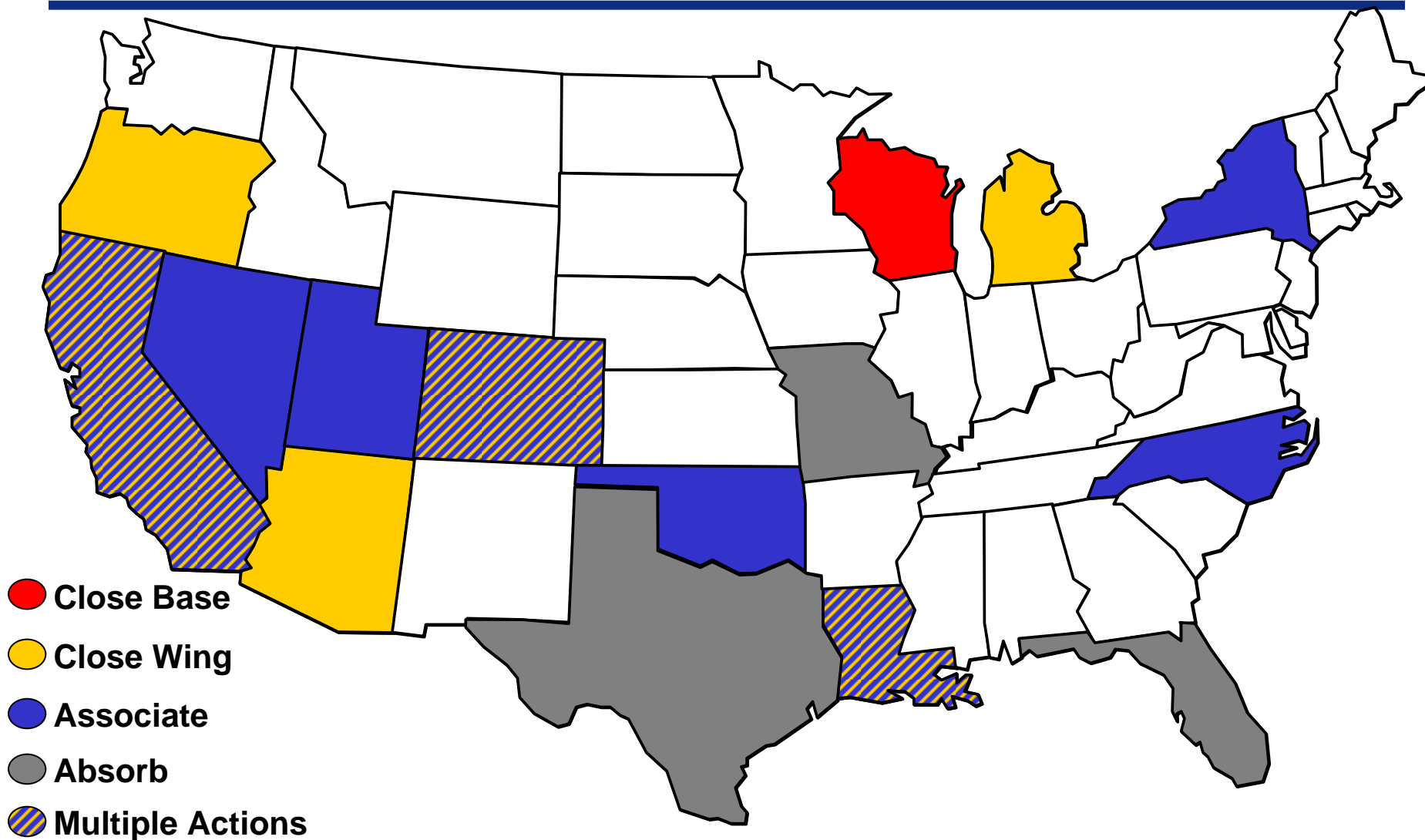


An Operational Reserve

- **Predominantly part-time force**
- **Trained and equipped on par with the active forces, allowing them to be ready on a moment's notice - no tiered readiness**
- **Volunteerism in lieu of mobilization is the guiding principle by which the Air Force employs the ARC, encouraging negotiated, mutually acceptable terms of service**
- **The establishment of the AEF construct has institutionalized a working partnership between the Active and RCs to meet AEF Total Force requirements**
- **Populate AF equipment, cockpits and ramps to best serve the mission – that means we will focus less on who owns the equipment and more on maximizing warfighter effects.**



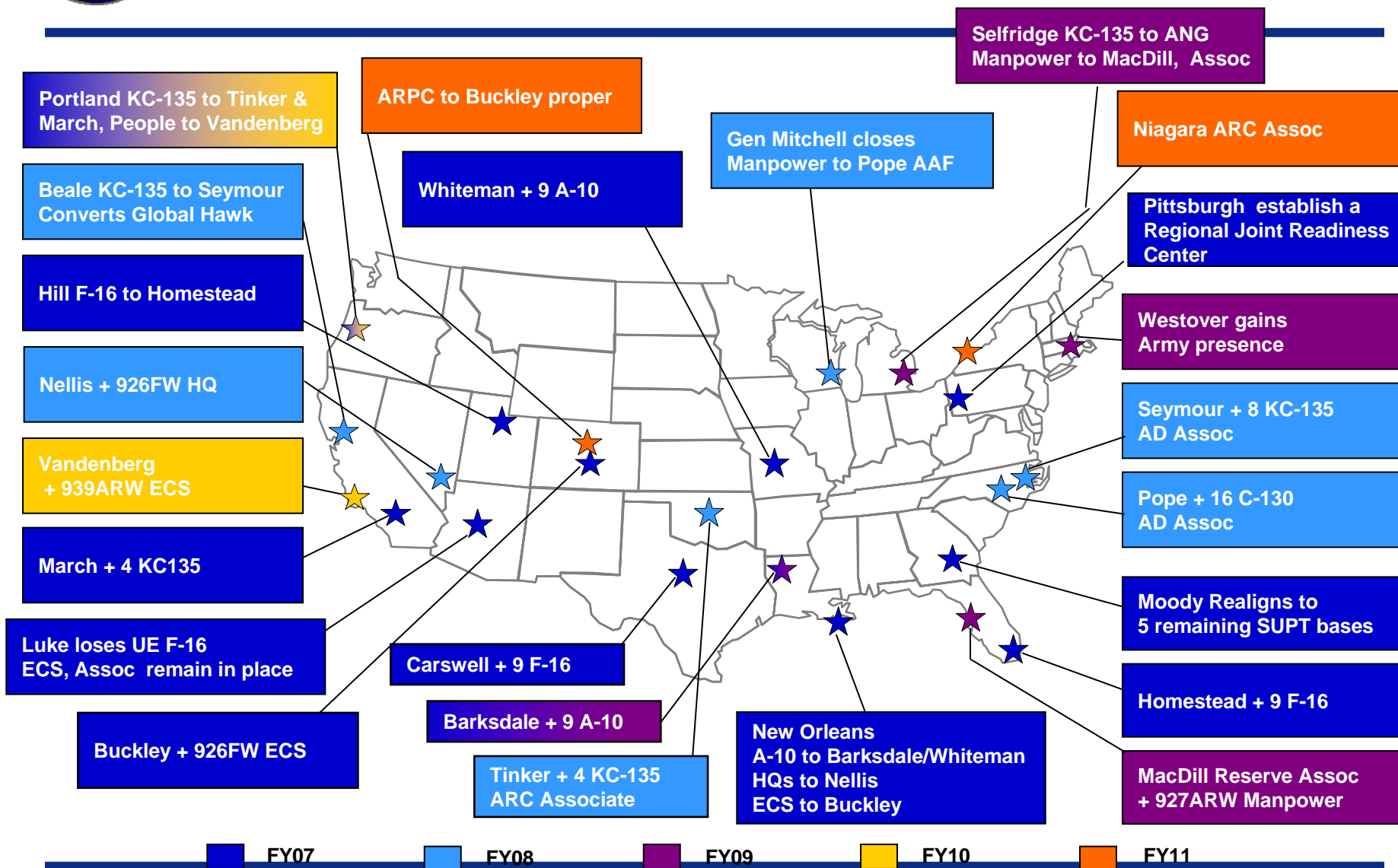

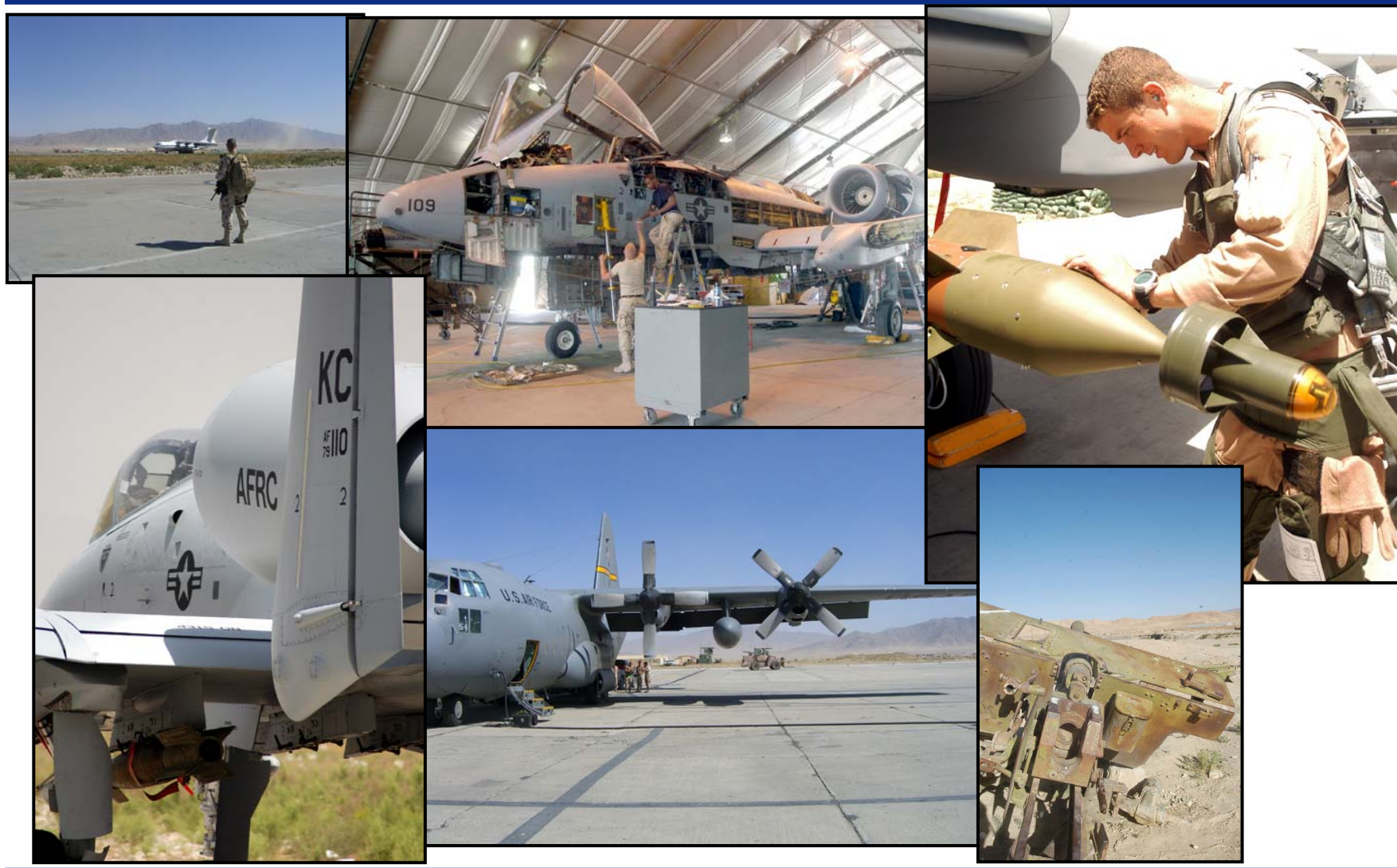
