

# Sample Memorandum That Can be Sent to Base and Unit Personnel

SUBJECT: Reasons for Joining the Air Force Association (AFA)

Please take a few minutes to consider joining the nearly 150,000 member Air Force Association.

Why? Because AFA is our professional organization, and aside from the many personal benefits of membership, AFA membership strengthens our voice in Washington and improves our ability to serve as Air Force professionals.

And the cost is very reasonable, only \$36 for one year or \$90 for three years. These dues rates include a monthly subscription to AIR FORCE Magazine as well as a variety of other personal benefits (see below).

## Benefits of AFA Membership

As the professional society of Air Force people, AFA's basic mission is to strengthen national defense by gaining Congressional and public support for Air Force personnel and resources. This helps both the country and Air Force people.

- Past accomplishments of the Air Force Association include across-the-board pay increases, transition services for personnel involuntarily separated from the Air Force such as health care, GI Bill, employment and relocation assistance, separation pay for enlisted personnel, enlistment bonuses, extension of the G.I. Bill, improvements in SGLI, retention of the commissary system, creation of the office of Chief Master Sergeant of the Air Force, degree granting authority for the Community College of the Air Force and a whole host of other less well known programs that improve the quality of life for those serving on active duty.
- Current objectives of the Association include working to ensure that members of Congress have accurate and up to date information on essential military programs to assure the best possible decision for the program, ensuring improvements to compensation and allowances for military personnel, and in general, continuing a strong Congressional commitment for our Armed Forces during a period of rapid international change and uncertainty.

As a large, national association, AFA also provides a wide range of more personal benefits for its members, benefits that are either not available from other sources or that are provided for AFA members at a lower cost. Among them are the following:
