Air Warfare Symposium Set for February 26-27

AFA's 25th Annual Air Warfare Symposium & Technology Exposition will be held at the Rosen Shingle Creek Hotel in Orlando, Florida. Speakers at the symposium include top Air Force, government and aerospace industry leaders.

As an AFA leader, you are invited to attend the symposium which will be held on Thursday, February 26, from 1:30 p.m. until 5:30 p.m., and on Friday, February 27, from 8:30 a.m. until noon.

The standard registration fee for the symposium is \$895 for non-AFA members and \$795 for an AFA individual member. However, since it is important for AFA leaders to attend this national event, there is a special leader registration fee (see attached registration form) for AFA National Officers, Region Presidents, Directors, National Committee Members, State and Chapter Presidents. [Note: Since this is not a directed meeting, this fee is not reimbursable for AFA leaders.] The registration fee includes both symposium sessions, a sandwich lunch, a reception/buffet honoring the symposium speakers on Thursday, and a continental breakfast on Friday morning. Each AFA leader who registers at this special rate will be entitled to purchase an additional ticket to the sandwich

All Congressional Memberships Expire December 31! Chapters Must Act Now!

Chapters with congressional members must take action **now** to begin (or extend) their membership in the Air Force Association. Chapters must act on **each** Member of the new Congress-- those newly elected, re-elected **and** those Senators who did not face re-election but continue to serve.

The Air Force Association realizes the critical importance of a healthy relationship with all of our elected officials and the particular link between AFA chapters and their national elected officials (both House and Senate). As a result AFA is again making complimentary memberships available for each of the members of the new, 111th Congress. However, these

memberships are available exclusively through AFA chapters and can only be initiated or continued if you take action.

All Members of Congress already receive a copy of *Air Force Magazine* in their office on Capitol Hill (as well as hundreds of other publications). The purpose of this complimentary membership program goes beyond that. It is to personalize and localize the membership, including chapter affiliation and the distribution of *Air Force Magazine*. That is why we are asking the local level (chapter or state) to act in extending these memberships and that is also why we are asking each Congressional applicant to use his or her **home address or home district office address**.

Enclosed is a list of the current AFA Congressional memberships. All these memberships will expire at the end of 2008 if they are not renewed by someone at the local level.

How to Renew Your Congressional Members

Two easy steps are required to extend the complimentary membership to your Representative or Senator:

- **Get the Member's Approval** (if he or she is not already an AFA member)

Complimentary Congressional membership requires the Member's approval. If you are renewing an existing membership or if one of your chapter people has a strong personal relationship with a Member of Congress, you needn't go through the process of advance correspondence to determine whether the Member is willing to accept a gift membership. Just go to the next step.

Otherwise write a letter to the Member of Congress from your chapter (or for the Senator, from the state organization) saying that the chapter/state desires to present the individual with a two-year membership in the Air Force Association and the

chapter/state organization. Once you receive a positive response, move up to the next step.

- **Send in an Application**

When a positive response is received, complete any AFA membership application in the name of the Member of Congress. Then write "**CONGRESSIONAL**" across the "Membership Options" section of the application. (Or you can download a Congressional membership Application off the web site.

<http://www.afa.org/members/CongApp.pdf> Be sure to indicate whether the individual has any military experience in the "Eligibility" section, include chapter information and write in the name of the unit president as the sponsor. When that is done, send the application to Judy Galbreath at AFA Headquarters.

You must fill out a new application for each complimentary member, whether the member is new or a renewal. We will not accept addresses on Capitol Hill. Use the Member of Congress' home address (in Washington or home district) or the home district office address.

When the completed Congressional application is received at headquarters, it will be processed, new member credentials will be mailed and the name will show up on your next interim roster. The membership will be valid for the balance of the current session of Congress, up to two years, and will expire December 31, 2010.

Subsequently, the Members of Congress should be included in all chapter mailings and invitations, and either the Chapter President or Vice President for Government Relations - or both - should keep up a reasonably frequent correspondence with these Members. Membership Awards Information

The membership award qualification period runs from July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009. We are already four months into the qualification period. Remember – any paid members recruited through the Member-Get-a-Member Campaign will also count towards your chapter's award numbers as long as you include the chapter number on the application!

Requests for National Officer or Headquarters Staff Support

All requests from the Field for support for an event either by one of your national officers or a headquarters staff member must come through the Field Services Division (Jim Simpson or Mary Nauheimer). Submit them as soon as the event date is known but before February 15th. The officers and senior staff will meet later in the month to set their calendars and commit to specific events so you should not expect a confirmation before the end of February.

In each case you should either use the Field Visit Request Form on the AFA Web at <http://www.afa.org/members/visit.pdf> OR provide the same information in an e-mail. Specifically, include the following:

- Type of Event to include location

- Type of support requested, e.g. speaker, workshop
- Any additional information that is relevant to the request
- Contact person information

New Procedure for Orders from the AFA “Store”

Effective October 1, 2008, all orders from the AFA “Store” will have to be accompanied by payment. We will no longer bill chapters. This is in keeping with standard business practices today (Amazon, Orbitz, etc.) and was brought about because AFA’s 2007 Audit revealed many chapters had bills that were overdue in excess of 180 days and some were over a year in arrears. The total of all bills owed is significant. Orders that arrive without payment will be returned or retained until we receive payment.

Planning Material is up on the AFA Website now

All of the material needed by chapter officers to begin their planning process for 2009 is on the AFA Web in the Field Resources section. Remember your Annual Activity and Financial Plans are due to Headquarters, endorsed by your state president (if applicable) and region president not later than December 31.

Region and State Presidents Meeting

Thirteen regions and 26 state organizations were represented at the annual Region and State Presidents Meeting, held in Arlington, Virginia, on October 16-18, hosted by Vice Chairman of the Board, Field Operations, Jim Lauducci.

Attendees heard presentations in three groups. AFA President/CEO Mike Dunn led the professional staff in discussing Headquarters activities and perspectives as they relate to the Field.

Vice Chairman of the Board, Aerospace Education, led presentations on the work of the Aerospace Education Council and a workshop that shared individual state approaches to Aerospace Education. Representatives from Texas, Utah and Virginia participated.

The balance of the meeting focused on Field Issues, principally the new planning and payment procedures which will be in place for 2009. Scott Van Cleef, former member of the Field Council and newly-elected National Director reprised the Planning Workshop he had conducted at the National Convention in September.

All presentation materials are on the AFA Web (Field Resources) in “Region and State Presidents Meeting Materials”. These include the handouts for the Virginia State AE presentation as well. However, material relating to the Strategic Plan, chapter plans and training for the new 2009 procedures are in a different section as indicated above. IRS Group Exemption Update

We’d like to thank the field leaders who helped us get to 190 pages: Dan Callahan, Chapter President AFA 230 MG Dan Callahan Chapter, TN; Nancy Driscoll, Chapter President AFA 257 Bob Hope Chapter, CA; Peter Lane, AFA 391 Denton Chapter, TX; John McCance, AFA State President Ohio; and Tom O’Shea, former State President Illinois.
