

Vice President for Professional Development

The Vice President for Professional Development is an appointed position by the Chapter President. He /she is the primary person responsible for developing and conducting Chapter programs to help mentor and develop Air Force active duty, Reserve and National Guard members.

Responsibilities include:

- Conduct the Gen Bernard Schriever Essay Contest in association with the 50th Space Wing and/or AFSPC
 - Provide winners' names to the Treasurer so checks can be cut
 - Provide winner' names to the VP for Communications for inclusion in the Chapter newsletter
- Developing programs to help mentor young officers and enlisted personnel highlighting leadership, professionalism, excellence, and commitment to duty, country, and the Air Force
- Act as the Chapter liaison with local military organizations and assist them in setting up programs as needed
- Provide articles to the VP for Communications for inclusion in the Chapter newsletter
- Maintain a Continuity Folder of how this job is performed. This will assist the successor in learning this job
