A1C William Pitsenbarger Full Measure Award (FMA) Application

Objectives

The Air & Space Forces Association (AFA) Pitsenbarger Full Measure Award (FMA) provides a one-time grant of \$3,000, a complimentary three-year AFA membership, and an invitation to receive the award the Air, Space & Cyber Conference to one previous Pitsenbarger Award winner who demonstrates a commitment to furthering their education, excellence in a Department of the Air Force role, and dedication to AFA's mission. Previous Pitsenbarger recipients wishing to apply should contact their local AFA Chapter or State President to learn about application deadlines and procedures.

Requirements/Selection Criteria

- CCAF degree with date, and a previous Pitsenbarger Award.
- Transcript from an accredited university showing a minimum of 12 credits with C grades or higher
- Letters of endorsement from the applicant's:
 - Squadron or Group/Delta commander, and
 - AFA Chapter or State President.
- Citations and awards representing distinguished activity should be included with the application
- A narrative statement describing your extracurricular activities and explaining their significance must be submitted with application. Emphasize those activities that indicate leadership, citizenship, teamwork, community service, personal development, and dedication. Also discuss other distinguishing activities and academic accomplishments. The narrative should also include undergraduate plans (e.g., school, field of study, future goals) and AFA participation.
- Applicants must be a member of AFA.

Grant Allocation and eMembership

- A plaque and a check in the amount of \$3000 will be presented at the ASC Conference
- AFA will send eMembership information to the email address provided on the Pitsenbarger application.

Guidelines

- Due to IRS regulations, recipients **must submit a W-9 form** to AFA. This form can be sent with the application, through DOD SAFE, or via this [Dropbox link](#).
- Selection is determined by a group of committee members from AFA's Education Council.
- The committee considers job performance, scholastic achievement, education goals and leadership qualities. Need is not a principal criterion. Prior recipients may not be considered.
- All Pitsenbarger grants are awarded based on available funds and are not guaranteed.





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Students are to submit this application (along with other required documentation) to their base education office. Signature acknowledges applicant has not ever been a prior Pitsenbarger Award recipient.
